Poetry contest guidelines:

This poetry contest is open to those aged 18 and over who reside in the Lower Columbia area. Awards will be presented for first and second place winners.

Poetry will be judged on:

Attention to contest theme: "Happiness. It comes on unexpectedly. And goes beyond, really, any early morning talk about it."

Poetic elements: use of poetic elements such as imagery, repetition, alliteration, use of stanzas, metaphor/simile, rhythm, rhyme, etc.

Creativity

- 1) Only two entries per person will be accepted, regardless of category.
- 2) Poems must be between 10 and 45 lines, including stanza breaks.
- 3) Poems must be received by 5pm on April 30th.
- 4) Clatskanie Library District is not responsible for late, lost, stolen, misdirected, damaged, incomplete or illegible submissions, or postage-due mail.
- 5) Confirmation of receipt and comments on your entry will not be provided, nor will your entry be returned to you.
- 6) There will be two winners selected. A \$100 prize will be awarded for first place and a \$50 prize will be awarded for second place.
- 7) Winners will be notified prior to the Raymond Carver Writing Festival.
- 8) Judges' decisions are final.
